

To all our volunteers,

Pizza Hut Park has instituted a new policy for any adult who may serve beer. Beginning this season, those who may be serving alcohol will be required to be TABC certified. This certification is good for 2 years and can be used at any venue that may serve alcohol. The average cost for this certification is \$20 and can be obtained via a live-training session, which is sometimes held at PHP (**a class is currently scheduled for 04/17**), or from a variety of approved vendors online. The training takes approximately 3 ½ - 4 hours to complete.

We realize this may be quite a lot to ask of our volunteers, but part of the way we raise revenue to offset various band costs is through fundraising efforts at PHP. We have signed up for several soccer games and concerts through the spring and summer and will need qualified volunteers to help us staff concession stands and portable beer stands. Not all adults who work in the stand need certification, only those who would be serving beer. Since the average concession stand has several beer taps, we need to have a good number of certified help so the same people do not work every event, which is unreasonable.

However, to make this process a little less painful, we will reimburse your certification cost! Simply complete your training, obtain your certificate, and work at least one of our scheduled events at PHP and we will pay you back for the cost of the course.
